

# Sponsor a Birthday Cake!

Help make this birthday special by sponsoring a birthday cake! We are looking for churches and organizations to help make a special birthday for families, young adults, and children in our residential programs.

Typically our residents aren't used to having a birthday celebration, so having a cake made just for them means so much! For the young adults transitioning out of foster care, you will make them feel loved and supported on their special day. For the parents in our Family Housing program, this lets them know they are not alone on their parenting journey as they work hard to regain their footing. For the children in our Family Housing program, this cake will make sure they can truly celebrate turning another year older.



What does sponsoring a birthday cake look like?

- Your church or organization would commit to providing a birthday cake or cupcakes on a particular month(s). You can pick out a cake from the store or donate a \$20 gift card per birthday (Publix, Kroger, or any Tucker/Decatur bakery). Due to food safety issues, we are unable to accept cakes made at home.
- Each month we have around 1-4 birthdays to celebrate. Although sometimes there are none, and sometimes we may have 7. This fluctuates as families enter and graduate from our programs.
- The month prior, you will get a list of the names, ages, any known allergies, any cake wishes, and delivery date.
- The last step is to make those wishes come true and drop off the cake at our office on the birthday (or Fridays for weekend birthdays).
