

Donate & Assemble Toiletries for Young Adults

Wellroot Family Services' Transitional and Independent Living Programs assist young adults who are transitioning out of the foster care system by offering housing, life skill development, and assistance in finishing high school/earning GED or entering college/trade school. Help these young adults feel welcomed and loved by collecting items and assembling one (1) to ten (10) toiletry kits.

Wellroot distributes comparable items to all our families and children. We request volunteers assemble similar packages but suggest volunteer groups add a personal touch by including a note of encouragement or prayer to each kit.

Each kit should contain:

- 1 shampoo
- 1 conditioner
- 2 soap bars
- 1 toothbrush
- 1 roll of toothpaste
- 1 new bath towel
- 1 new washcloth
